

WHAT DOES "DEVIATED FIXED ROUTE" MEAN?

The bus operates along a route with a regular schedule, but can also leave the route for "off-route" drop-offs or pick-ups. The number of deviations per run is limited and must be scheduled in advance by calling (541) 296-7595.

Only deviations within 1/4 mile of the route are allowed. Time is built into the schedule to allow for deviations. This means the bus may get to the stops earlier than the scheduled time if there are no deviations, but the bus will not leave that stop until the time posted in the schedule.

PAYMENTS ACCEPTED

Cash: Exact change needed.

Checks: Made out to MCEDD.

Tickets: Books of ten ride tickets can be purchased from a driver or at our office. Credit cards are accepted at our office.

Tickets can also be purchased on the Journey or Passage apps.

FARES

Children (10 and under) = FREE

General Public = \$1.00 each way, or use the GOrge Pass on Blue and Red Routes for unlimited rides.

Centenarians (100+) = FREE

GUIDELINES

The Gorge TransLink providers prioritize maintaining a safe and comfortable environment for all passengers and drivers. Riders who do not follow guidelines may be expelled and/or suspended from using the service.

PETS

- · All dogs must be on leash.
- No dogs on seats; they must remain either on the floor or on the owner's lap.
- All other animals must be in a confined container or carrier.
- Drivers may refuse to transport or may request the removal of an animal if it is creating a hazard or disturbance
- Service animals as defined under ADA regulations Part 37 are welcome aboard the Gorge TransLink provider vehicles.

BIKES

- Bike racks are to be used when available.
 Other options may be available on a case-by-case basis.
- · Space for the bike is first come first served.
- · Riders must secure their own bikes

KIDS

The public transit system welcomes all riders. However, bus drivers have the right to refuse service to any rider 10 and under who is without supervision. Call your local provider to find out if pre-authorization for young riders is needed.

LUGGAGE, BAGS, STROLLERS

Passengers must be able to carry on their bags and luggage at one time and place them under the seat or in their laps. Don't block aisles or doors. Drivers cannot assist with bags. Strollers should be folded.

HOLIDAYS

Gorge TransLink providers follow federal holidays, which may fall on a Friday or Monday, and CAT offers weekend service levels during holidays.

New Year's Day, MLK Day, Presidents' Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, 4th of July, Labor Day, Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving Thursday and Friday, Christmas Day.

DIAL-A-RIDE

The Link also operates door-to-door Dial-A-Ride service within The Dalles, Mosier, Dufur, Celilo, and points between. Everyone is welcome to ride for any purpose. The cost is \$2.00, the GOrge Pass cannot be used for Dial-A-Ride services.

Call 541-296-7595 to schedule your ride. Hours are Monday—Friday, 6:00am to 7:00pm, and Saturday & Sunday, 9:00am to 4:00pm.

ACCESSIBILITY

The Link buses are mobility device accessible and drivers are trained to assist passengers with disabilities.

SHOPPING BUS

The shopping bus will drop off riders anywhere in The Dalles and makes a Hood River run twice a month. The bus typically runs Mondays and Wednesdays, 10:00am to 2:00pm. The driver can assist with carrying groceries on and off the bus if needed. No bag limit. Call for details. Cost is \$3 for unlimited stops.
